### LEARNING CURVE BY ROB DUIKER

### DO WE STILL WANT A KING LIKE DAVID?

When I go to a Christian concert, one of my pet peeves is the talk. Typically, I'll be muttering to myself something like, "I came for the music; not a bunch of short sermons." This week when I attended the Brian Doerksen concert at the Alliance Church the pattern reversed unexpectedly. I found myself reflecting more on Doerksen's words between songs than on the music.

To be honest, I cannot remember his exact words because I immediately embellished them with my own thought processes. At one point he commented on the reality that the Jews before the birth of Jesus were expecting a messiah who would be a king like David. I'm not certain if this is what Doerksen intended or not, but I began to ponder, "Do we still want a King like David?" "Does the church, or some broad cross section of Christians still long for the exercise of political power in the name of Jesus?" "Is that the Jesus we want, even today?"

The Jesus I know was born in a manger and made no attempt to wield political power. The Prince of Peace did not aspire to overthrow the Romans. He brought a very different kind of peace. His Kingship was characterized by meekness and humility.

As I sat there in the back row of the Alliance church sanctuary, I pondered the ways that Christians today exercise political might. I recollected the times that Christians filled rooms at political gatherings and raised their collective voices in support of Christian ideas that might one day become Christian laws. I considered the ways that we engage battles in public discourse where we might not distinguish ourselves as people who exercise political power in a different way than those who do not know Jesus.

I reflected on the recent resignation of Andrew Scheer as the leader of the Conservative Party of Canada. What kind of leader were Christians expecting him to be? Did he fail to be the kind of leader who would conquer the foe? Was our expectation of him perhaps a little bit like that of the Jews expecting a king like David?

I puzzled about the popular carol lines, "Born to set Thy people free!" and, "He rules the world with truth and grace." He is that kind of King!

So I now wrestle with the question, "Is Jesus the kind of king that we want? …because He has to be! If we are still waiting for a Jesus who rules the world with something other than truth and grace, we are missing the real Jesus. Is it our mission to make Canada prove the glories of His righteousness and wonders of His love? How about Rocky Mountain House or just Rocky Christian School? Every day we are called to prove the wonders of Jesus love and the glories of His righteousness. What does that require? I think we have work to do.

I don't know if my ponderings about King Jesus do justice to what Doerksen was trying to communicate, but they did stir up a deep longing for a King; for a Messiah! Joy to the world, the LORD is come!! Let earth receive her King!! Glory to the Newborn King!!

children attending our school there to answer any other questions that you may have. So bring your child along to meet the teacher and take a tour of our school.


Know of other families with kindergarten aged children who may not have heard about our school? Please share this invitation with them as well.
