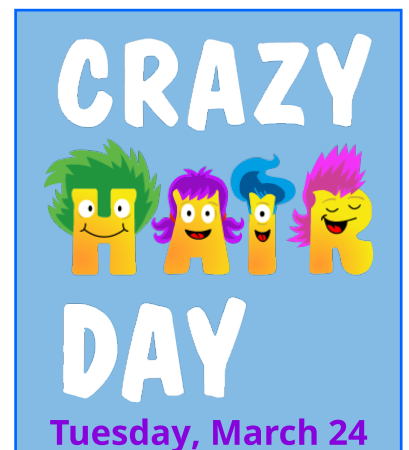

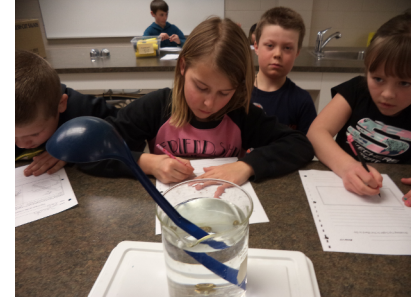
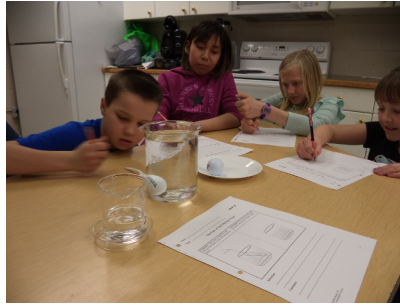
Jill Dahle, one of our valued EA's, spent some time teaching our students how to cross-country ski.
