## Tribute to My Mother Rob Duiker

Many of you know that I spent the past week in Ontario to attend the funeral of my mother. One of my tasks associated with this bittersweet milestone in the life of our family was to prepare and deliver a eulogy on behalf of my siblings. While my mother's skills and accomplishments were many, one of the things I said about her was this:

Christian Education was of critical importance to Mom. In the Acton area she was known as Mrs. Christian High School. In fact, she terrorized people with her relentless pursuit of funds for Christian schools. She was tenacious in raising funds for the Georgetown Christian School and Toronto District Christian High School.

If she were to come to your door, she wasn't leaving until she had a donation. She always exceeded the fundraising goal set for the Acton area, while the other areas consistently missed their targets.

Every Christian school needs a Wilhelmina Duiker; someone who believes in it that much. For her, Christian Education was vitally important for passing the faith on to the generations that follow us.

In the pews at my mother's funeral I could see children, grandchildren, and great-children, all of whom were impacted by my mother's devout Christian life, and many of whom were impacted by the Christian schools that were so dear to her.

As we reflect on the 50 years that Rocky Christian School has been in existence, I wonder who the Wilhelmina Duikers have been in our history. It is obviously true that churches, Christian schools and other Christian causes require substantial amounts of money to build and to operate. The job of being the person that asks for that money is not one that many people desire. We owe a debt of gratitude to the folks who did that job on our behalf over the past 50 years.

As we reflect on the next 50 years we know that we will have to do some building. We hope that our school grows, requiring us to add to the size of our current facility. We know that the building will need to be replaced one day as a natural consequence of aging. Who will be the people who believe in Christian Education so much that they will pay for it? Who will be the people who ask for those contributions?

As we scan the pews of churches this Sunday, look around for people whose lives have been enriched by Christian Education. Notice how Rocky Christian School has helped families over the years to pass on a devout Christian faith to the next generation.

They say that people will pay for whatever they believe in. I encourage you to think a lot about Christian Education and consider the role it plays in building up the body of Christ. I encourage you to believe in it as one effective way to help us carry out the most important ministry of all ... the ministry of preparing our children for a Christian life.
