There are people who believe that our school would be a great place to enroll their children because we have good kids. There is some truth to this; at least I like to think so. When we teach our students about the fruit of the Spirit ... love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control ... they usually pay attention and they realize that these are exactly the same things that they are taught at home and church. However, it would be a mistake to think that sin is not a reality at Rocky Christian School.

There is a fallacy that is represented in books, TV shows, movies, and video games that there are good guys and bad guys ... good girls and bad girls. Children will sometimes play cops and robbers following a model that says the world is made up of good people and evil people. If only it was that simple.

About the sinfulness of every human, the Bible is abundantly clear. Ecclesiastes 7:20 says, "Indeed, there is no one on earth who is righteous, no one who does what is right and never sins." Paul repeats this in Romans 3 where we find the oft memorized passage, "As it is written: "There is no one righteous, not even one."

If our TV shows, video games, movies and books are to present the world as it really is, good and evil should not be represented by people. Rather, they are duking it out in the heart of every person. Children playing cops and robbers must eventually see each constable as a broken justice seeker pursuing the similarly broken justice avoider. The difference between us is not our good and evil. It is Grace!

Fortunately for the world, grace is not only bestowed upon Christians. We are not the only ones who are blessed with the ability to see and do good. We are the ones who see that the job of conquering evil is too big for us. We are the ones who understand how big our sin really is. We are the ones who understand that Jesus is the solution to our sin problem

After Paul repeated the Biblical truth that no-one is righteous, in Chapter 4 he said this:

If you're a hard worker and do a good job, you deserve your pay; we don't call your wages a gift. But if you see that the job is too big for you, that it's something only God can do, and you trust Him to do it—you could never do it for yourself no matter how hard and long you worked—well, that trusting-him-to-do-it is what gets you set right with God, by God. Sheer gift. (Romans 4:4&5 The Message)

In Matthew 13:24-30 we find the parable of the Wheat and the Weeds. I grew up thinking of the Wheat and the weeds as people. As an adult I learned another explanation, that each of us has wheat and weeds battling it out within us. That battle will continue until Jesus returns.

Like every school, Rocky Christian School has a sin problem. Every student and staff member has a sin problem. But we know that Jesus is bigger than our sin. So we take Jesus with us on the playground and into the classroom doing a job that we cannot do no matter how hard we try. We invite Jesus continually to spray our weeds and to fertilize our wheat.

IDENTITY IN CHRIST





PAJAMA Sti Students (and staff) got to enjoy the day in their pajamas on January 26. It also turned out to be a very chilly day. How much better could it get -










WELCOME TO NARNIA!
