LEARNING CURVE BY ROB DUIKER

In Grade 6 & 7 we recently read the book Prince Caspian by C.S Lewis. One theme in this book is the stark difference between believers and unbelievers. Believers are symbolized by the Old Narnians—those who remained true to Aslan (who represents Jesus). The Old Narnians are characterized as those who "believe in fairy tales." In the book King Miraz berates Caspian, the rightful king: "That's all nonsense, for babies...Only fit for babies, do you hear? You're getting too old for that sort of stuff."

The comparison to Christians whose faith is challenged in high schools and universities is unmistakable. Lewis is drawing a parallel to the Christian life in that our faith will always be ridiculed and sneered at by those who will see it as foolishness. Paul reminds us that, "The message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing but to us who are being saved it is the power of God" (1 Corinthians 1:18).

Lewis also consistently directs a harsh indictment towards schools. In The Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe, Professor Kirke, when approached by Lucy's concerned older siblings about her tendency to believe the unbelievable, wondered aloud, "I wonder what they do teach them at these schools." In 'Prince Caspian' Lewis suggests that there is an underlying political agenda to present Biblical truth as foolishness, and one cannot escape the role that schools play in carrying out this agenda.

In the book, Prince Caspian's teacher must take him to a secret and secure location in order to teach him truths about Narnia, because the teaching of these truths has become illegal.

"The virtue of this tower," said Doctor Cornelius, "is that we have six empty rooms beneath us, and a long stair, and the door at the bottom of the stair is locked. We cannot be overheard."

"Are you going to tell me what you wouldn't tell me the other day?" said Caspian.

"I am," said the Doctor. "But remember. You and I must never talk about these things except here—on the very top of the Great Tower."

"No. That's a promise," said Caspian. "But do go on, please."

"Listen," said the Doctor. "All you have heard about Old Narnia is true. It is not the land of Men. It is the country of Aslan, the country of the Walking Trees ... (and many more unbelievable things). The King does not allow them to be spoken of."

Lewis consistently strongly advocated for an understanding of the universe that was far richer, and more confounding, and awesome, and amazing, than one which could be understood by scientific reasoning alone. Christian schools teach for that kind of understanding of the universe. Science and reason are important, but they cannot tell the whole story. At Rocky Christian School we stand in awe of a God whose works are too wonderful to understand. We believe the unbelievable truth that Jesus died and rose from the dead! That's what we teach at Rocky Christian School. I think CS Lewis would approve!
