# RCS SCHOOL COLOURS DAY



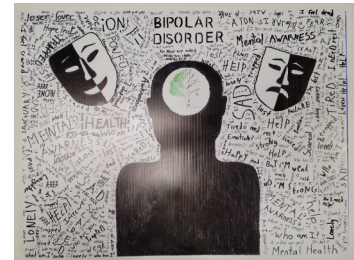
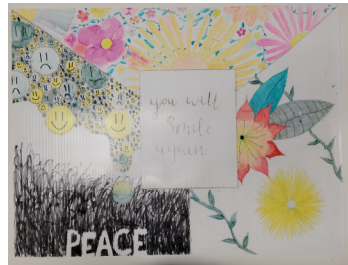
