NOTES FROM THE OFFICE

You should have seen an email come through from WRSD notifying you that a school form requires your attention. This is our online Demographic Confirmation Report. Please be sure to log in and complete the form for each of your students. Once the first student is done, you can simply "Copy From Previous Form" to save time. Make sure to click on the Save button before proceeding to the next page so that any changes that you make are saved.

If you are having difficulty logging in, please give me a call and I will happily walk through it with you.

Volunteer Requirements

Just a quick recap of what is required to volunteer in our school:

Criminal Record Check

please note that a criminal record does not automatically disqualify someone from volunteering at the school. In the case of a volunteer showing a criminal record, in consultation with senior leadership and based on the individual case, permission may be granted to allow volunteerism, with specific duties. eg: a drunk driving conviction would not disqualify someone from volunteering as a chaperone on a field trip but would not be appropriate as a volunteer driver.

Child Intervention Record Check

To request a Child Intervention Record Check please email cs-ircrequest@gov.ab.ca

The following is required to be a volunteer **driver** for any situation where parents might be driving students other than their own children. This is primarily for extra-curricular activities:

- A current (within 12 months) Driver's abstract must be on file at the school
 - drivers with more than 6 demerits are not permitted to drive on school sponsored activities
 - ► The school will cover the cost of obtaining Driver's Abstracts. Bring in your receipt and we will reimburse you.
- Proof of a minimum of \$1,000,000 liability insurance coverage on file at the school.

HOT LUNCH & MILK PROGRAM

We hope to be able to offer our Hot Lunch and Milk programs again this year, but as we are still dealing with a bit of uncertainty around our current level of attendance and changing restrictions, we feel it would be better to wait for a month or so before going forward with either program at this point. Watch for order forms to come home when we are confident that it is safe to proceed.

About the Programs

► **Hot Lunch** ~ The first Tuesday of each month we have a dedicated crew of parents who



come in and prepare a delicious homemade meal for everyone at the school. Order forms will come home telling you what the meal will be. You can order for all of your students on one order form - choosing the type of milk, etc. The cost of meals will be \$3.50/per student/month. Every student will be provided

a meal if they want one, regardless of payment. We also have a "Pay it Forward" option to make sure that our hot lunch program is accessible by all.

Milk Program ~ is ordered on a monthly basis. You may choose the days you would like your student to have milk as well as the type of milk for each day. If a student is absent, parents may keep track of how many days and deduct the value of the milk for that many days from their next month's order. They may also consider it a donation to the school. Also, if you know your child(ren) will be absent in the coming month, you can calculate that in your payment; please write on the form how many days you are paying for and the dates that they will be absent.

Hot lunch days are not included on the milk order forms; if you would like your student to have milk on hot lunch days, please order it on the hot lunch form even if your student doesn't want the meal.

Michael is a twelve year old boy who lives in Koari, Bolivia. He is in grade seven and he likes to play ball. Our school has supported Michael through World Vision since he was quite small. We receive yearly updates and letters from him. Each month we send \$49.00 to

help improve living conditions, help provide education, and to let Michael know that he is loved. We take a collection every Thursday in Chapel, so if your child is asking for money for Michael, please consider donating. On occasion we also hold special student fundraisers to help raise extra funds for special projects in Michael's community.






TERRY FOX RUN - SEPTEMBER 29, 2021

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
