Pondering Remembrance

In 1953 my parents immigrated to Canada from the Netherlands. They could have chosen some other country to move to in search of a better life, but for them Canada was the obvious choice.

Eight years prior to their immigration, in 1945, the Netherlands celebrated something they called the Canadian Summer. On May 5 of that year, Canadian general Charles Foulkes accepted the surrender of the German forces in the Netherlands at Wageningen. The summer that followed was a summer of celebrating the joyful arrival of peace. The significant Canadian military presence in the Netherlands at the end of the war in Europe was a cause of an outpouring of love by the Dutch towards Canada that continues to this day.



I am sometimes concerned about Canada and what it has become. But as a Canadian I still beam with pride when I consider how it was Canadians who liberated the homeland of my parents in 1944 and 1945. I sometimes reflect on what the world might have become had Canada and the Allied Forces not stepped up to risk life and limb to defeat Hitler and his Nazi regime. I think about it even more nowadays when the likes of Hamas and Vladimir Putin wreak havoc in parts of the world that are far away from here. Will we ever experience another Canadian Summer?

On Remembrance Day we remember things that happened before we were born; things that have profoundly shaped the world in which we live. It is on Remembrance Day that I remember many of the reasons why I cherish the right to call myself a Canadian. On each Remembrance Day I am thankful anew for all of the rights and freedoms that I have but that many people around the globe do not have. Chief among them is the right to worship the one true God. I hope that rights to worship, congregate, speak, evangelize, and to live would still today be defended, to the death if necessary, in Canada.

This past weekend I visited the field of crosses in Calgary. To stand among the crosses is an odd thing. At one time you experience both pride and sorrow. We viewed memorials of soldiers as young as 17. I can't imagine losing a loved one that young, in battle. But I can remember, because that is what we do on Remembrance Day.

This form is essentially your student's registration form and "blanket" Local Field Trip Permission form for this school year. If you could complete it as soon as possible, that would be greatly appreciated.

Volunteer Requirements

Just a quick recap of what is required to volunteer in our school:

- Criminal Record Check
 - o please note that a criminal record does not automatically disqualify someone from volunteering at the school. In the case of a volunteer showing a criminal record, in consultation with senior leadership and based on the individual case, permission may be granted to allow volunteerism, with specific duties. eg: a drunk driving conviction would not disqualify someone from volunteering as a chaperone on a field trip but would not be appropriate as a volunteer driver.

The following is required to be a volunteer **driver** for any situation where parents might be driving students other than their own children. This is primarily for extra-curricular activities:

- A current (within 12 months) Driver's abstract must be on file at the school
 - Please contact the school office for the form to apply for this
- drivers with more than 6 demerits are not permitted to drive on school sponsored activities
- Drivers with a GDL license are not permitted to drive students
- Proof of a minimum of \$1,000,000 liability insurance coverage on file at the school
