"And now I will show you the most excellent way." There is often talk around schools these days about excellence in education. We are all interested in what the Rocky Christian School Mission Statement calls, "Excellence in Christ centred education." To help us come to an understanding of what it means to be excellent in Biblical terms, one thing that might inform our thoughts on the subject is the passage that follows I Corinthians 12.

I Corinthians 13 is the passage commonly known as the love passage. It begins with the words, "If I speak in the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love; I am only a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal." Love is the most excellent way! If we desire education that is more than loud noise it must be love education. To paraphrase the passage, if my son or daughter becomes a world famous doctor or lawyer, but does not have love, they have become nothing.

⁴Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. ⁵It is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. ⁶Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. ⁷It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. ⁸Love never fails. But where there are prophecies, they will cease; where there are tongues, they will be stilled; where there is knowledge, it will pass away.

We desire many excellent things for our children. We may yearn for them to become intellectual or athletic or skilful in music or art. We may seek an education for them that focuses on these pursuits. And while the elite performers in every field of endeavour are seen as successful in the eyes of the world, a more heavenly view of success comes with character traits akin to Love. Traits such as kindness, compassion, loyalty, friendship, diligence, courage, patience, gentleness, joyfulness, self-control, and generosity are signs of a successful Christian life. Learning these things might not get you a high paying job, but they will help you with your vocation if that vocation is serving Christ.

We may desire many excellent things for our children but the most excellent of these is love. Before anything else, we want to be a school that produces excellent, loving graduates who are passionate disciples of our Lord Jesus Christ.

You should have seen an email come through from WRSD notifying you that a school form requires your attention. This is our online Demographic Confirmation Report. Please be sure to log in and complete the form for each of your students. Once the first student is done, you can simply "Copy From Previous Form" to save time. Make sure to click on the Save button before proceeding to the next page so that any changes that you make are saved.

If you are having difficulty logging in, please give me a call and I will happily walk through it with you.

This form is essentially your student's registration form for this school year. If you could complete it as soon as possible, that would be greatly appreciated.

Volunteer Requirements

Just a quick recap of what is required to volunteer in our school:

- > Criminal Record Check
 - o please note that a criminal record does not automatically disqualify someone from volunteering at the school. In the case of a volunteer showing a criminal record, in consultation with senior leadership and based on the individual case, permission may be granted to allow volunteerism, with specific duties. eg: a drunk driving conviction would not disqualify someone from volunteering as a chaperone on a field trip but would not be appropriate as a volunteer driver.

The following is required to be a volunteer **driver** for any situation where parents might be driving students other than their own children. This is primarily for extra-curricular activities:

- A current (within 12 months) Driver's abstract must be on file at the school
 - Please contact the school office for the form to apply for this
- drivers with more than 6 demerits are not permitted to drive on school sponsored activities
- Drivers with a GDL license are not permitted to drive students
- Proof of a minimum of \$1,000,000 liability insurance coverage on file at the school
